Youth In Need to Honor Three Community Leaders at 23rd Annual Celebration of Youth

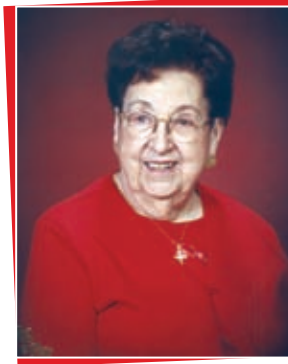

The Easter Bunny will make a special visit to St. Charles County's Youth Activity Park on Saturday, April 3. With thousands of candy-filled eggs hidden throughout the 25-acre facility, participants are sure to enjoy a hopping good time at the 5th Annual YAP Easter Egg Hunt.

For just \$5 per child, the YAP Easter Egg Hunt offers a host of fun activities. To make the search safer and easier for all participants, separate egg hunts are planned for toddlers 3 and under (10:15 a.m.), kids ages 4-6 (11 a.m.), and those 7-12 (11:45 a.m.). At the conclusion of the egg hunts, the fun-filled day will also present egg-themed games for kids and their families. As a take-home gift, the Easter Bunny will be available for photos with participants throughout the event.

Each hunt is limited to the first 100 participants, so advanced registration is required. At least one adult guardian must accompany park guests under the age of 12 at the event. However, only one person may assist toddlers (under 3) on their search,
