



Youth In Need's Project Safe Place

What? Project Safe Place is a preventative program aimed at children and teens in crisis situations. When a young person is in need of a "safe place," local businesses, designated by the yellow and black Safe Place sign, serve that purpose temporarily until a Youth In Need staff member can meet with the child and offer support, a place to stay, transportation or other resources as needed.



Who? Throughout St. Louis and St. Charles County, Project Safe Place is managed by Youth In Need, an organization that provides residential group homes, early-childhood education, homeless street outreach, counseling, support groups and foster care case management to children, teens and families in the eastern Missouri region.

Where? We welcome any business that would like to become a Safe Place site. The more locations there are, the more children we can help. Children and teens recognize the Safe Place sign as a symbol of help, and the more visible it is, the better it is for the young people in our community!

When? We are welcoming new Safe Place sites at any time. We would be pleased to set up your site, train your employees and continue correspondence throughout this new journey of crisis prevention in eastern Missouri.

Why? Your assistance in the Safe Place initiative would offer help to children in their time of need. A small amount of effort could make a huge difference in a young person's life, and your support will be dedicated to those within your own community.
